A. Duties and Responsibilities

1. Provides research and technical support to the NEDA Board-National Land Use Committee (NB-NLUC) and its Technical Board (TB).
2. Gathers technical inputs/data/information necessary for the:
 - Resolution of land use policy conflicts among agencies of the national government;
 - Formulation/updating of national physical framework plan and other inter-sectoral policies and programs that guide the rational utilization and management of land and other physical resources; and
 - Integration of land use and physical planning policies, plans and programs, including disaster risk management, into national socioeconomic plans and program.
3. Prepares discussion papers and other support materials for the NB-NLUC and TB meetings.
4. Attends and provides technical support to the Chairman of NB-NLUC and its TB in meetings and activities of other inter-agency committees involved in land use and physical planning.
