ASIA--ECONOMIC POLICY

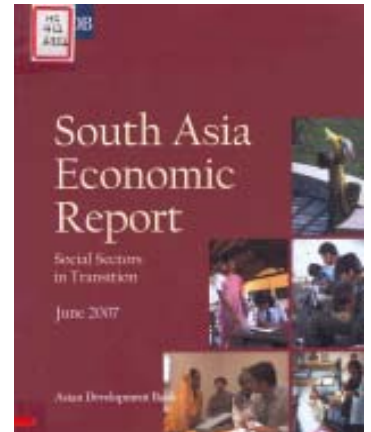

South Asia economic report: social sectors in transition Asian Development Bank (c2007)

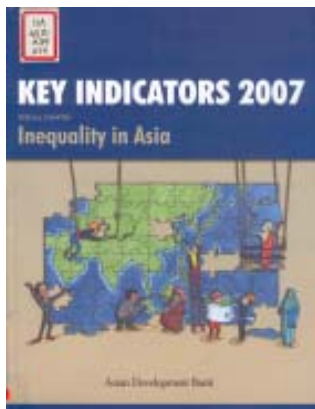
SOUTH ASIA--SOCIAL POLICY

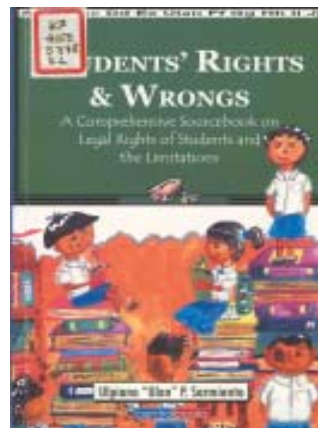

Students' rights and wrongs: a comprehensive sourcebook on legal rights of students and the limitations Sarmiento, Ulpiano III P. (c2006)



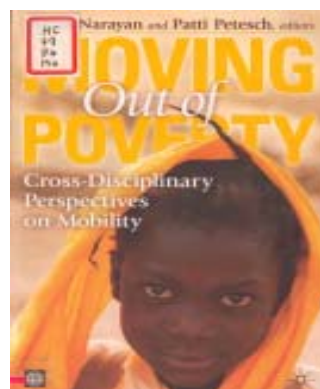
STUDENTS--LEGAL STATUS, LAWS, ETC.--PHILIPPINES
