

Hereunder are further clarifications on the above procurement:

Particulars	Clarification/Amendment
a. Qualification of Project Manager / Team Leader	A Consulting Firm may propose a Project Manager / Team Leader that holds a degree other than those related to agriculture or fishery but with considerable experience (i.e., at least 10 years) in port planning, including fish port planning.
b. Conduct of Socioeconomic Survey under Annex C of the TOR	The winning Consulting Firm is expected to conduct a Socioeconomic Survey among communities around the five (5) regional fish ports included in the Study. The cost for the conduct of such survey is already included under Reimbursable Expenses which has an estimated amount of PhP5.88 million. The revised Annex C of the TOR is hereby attached for reference/perusal.
c. Flexibility with Budget	<p>Consulting Firms shall have flexibility to reallocate the budgets for Remuneration and Reimbursable Expenses; provided, that the reallocation shall not be more than 20 percent (i.e., <math>\pm 20\%</math>) from the allocated budgets for the same as indicated in the TOR and shall not exceed the Approved Budget for the Contract (ABC).</p> <p>The Contract <i>is not</i> a “Lumpsum” Contract. Billing for Reimbursable Items shall be <i>based on actual expenses incurred</i> and supported by official receipts/documents, including the monthly progress reports. In the absence of official receipts/documents, the winning Consulting Firm may be allowed to submit a certification of actual disbursements made <i>under oath (duly notarized)</i>.</p> <p>Billing for Remuneration, on the other hand, shall be in accordance with the Delivery Schedule provided under Section 12.2 of the TOR and subject to the usual</p>

	Government accounting and auditing requirements.
