National Filariasis Elimination Program	The program aims to eliminate filariasis as a public health problem, by reducing its prevalence rate to <1/1000 population. The program's current interventions include: a) strengthening surveillance systems to identify other endemic areas and sustain the elimination status of provinces; b) Mass Drug Administration (MDA) in endemic areas for all persons 2 years old and above; c) procurement of disability management kits for lymphedema and elephantitis patients; d) capacity-building of health workers; and e) LGU empowerment for community-based implementation.	http://www.doh.gov.ph	Department of Health (DOH)
Nutrition-Strategic Framework for Comprehensive Nutrition Implementation Plan, 2016-2025.	The plan aims to achieve the following strategic objective by 2025: a) reduce anemia prevalence in women of reproductive age; b) increase the rate of exclusive breastfeeding in the first 6 months of life; c) reduce childhood stunting and wasting; d) reduce the number infants born with low birth weight; e) reduce micronutrient deficiencies to levels below public health significance; f) reduce the exposure of population to non-communicable diseases (NCDs)-related risks; and g) ensure that there is no increase in the prevalence of childhood and adult obesity.	http://www.doh.gov.ph	Department of Health (DOH)
