REQUEST FOR EXPRESSION OF INTEREST (EOI) AND SUBMISSION OF ELIGIBILITY DOCUMENTS FOR THE PROCUREMENT OF EVALUATION CONSULTANT FOR THE MONITORING AND EVALUATION (M&E) FUND

1. The National Economic and Development Authority (NEDA), through the Monitoring and Evaluation Staff (MES), shall engage the services of an Evaluation Consultant (foreign or local) to jumpstart and ensure the efficient and effective conduct of (i) monitoring and evaluation, and other related studies, in priority areas; and, (ii) capacity building activities for NEDA and selected stakeholders. The Approved Budget for the Contract (ABC) is **TWO MILLION, EIGHT HUNDRED FIFTY THOUSAND and 00/100 PESOS (Php2,850,000.00)**, inclusive of all applicable government taxes and charges.
2. The NEDA now calls for the submission of EOI and eligibility requirements for the conduct of the abovementioned undertaking as indicated under Sections 24.1 and 24.2 of the Revised Implementing Rules and Regulations (IRR) of Republic Act (RA) No. 9184 and in the Eligibility Documents / Eligibility Data Sheet (EDS)¹. Interested Consultants should submit their eligibility requirements on or before **07 June 2016 (Tuesday), 12:00 P.M.** at the following address:

3. Only individual consultants may participate in the bidding process for this Consulting Services. Consulting Firms, however, may nominate a consultant (organic or otherwise) to participate in the bidding process provided it shall comply with the eligibility requirements for Firms as provided in Section 2.1 of the Eligibility Documents / EDS. Only those Consultants who will submit EOI and pay the corresponding participation fee of **Php2,000.00**, together with the required eligibility requirements, and determined to be eligible pursuant to Sections 24.1 and 24.2 of the Revised IRR of RA 9184 and shortlisted in accordance with applicable experience/qualifications (i.e., track record and qualification of key personnel) and job capacity shall be directly invited in the subsequent selection process.
4. Interested Consultants may submit their Legal, Financial and Class "B" Eligibility Documents, as applicable, in advance (**on or before 27 May 2016, 4:00 P.M.**) for preliminary evaluation by the NBAC-CS in terms of completeness/compliance. The NBAC-CS, however, shall only proceed with the preliminary evaluation when the required participation fee of Php2,000.00 has been paid. Said amount shall cover the



attendant administrative cost for the eligibility check and shortlisting process and shall be deducted from the cost of the Bidding Documents which the participating shortlisted Consultants are required to purchase. The NBAC-CS, after its preliminary evaluation of advance submissions, shall inform the participating Consultants of any deficiency in their respective submissions at least three (3) calendar days prior to the deadline for submission of Eligibility Documents set in this Request for EOI. Technical Documents submitted in advance shall not be eligible for preliminary evaluation and should be submitted in separate sealed envelope and shall be opened on the schedule indicated in the invitation/notices issued for the purpose.

5. Eligibility and Selection will be conducted through open competitive selection process using non-discretionary "pass/fail" criterion as specified in RA 9184 and its Revised IRR. Proposals shall be evaluated using the Quality-Based Evaluation/Selection (QBE/QBS) procedure. The criteria with rating system for the evaluation of proposals shall be provided in the Instructions to Bidders (ITB).
6. NEDA reserves the right to reject any and all proposals, including that of a single eligible proponent, waive any minor deviation in the submitted documents which will not materially affect the substance of the proposal, annul the bidding process, or not award the contract without thereby incurring any liability to the affected participating Consultant/s.
