
Procurement of Consulting Services for the Conduct of Scoping Study on International Migration Statistics in the Philippines

Hereunder are clarifications on the procurement for the above consulting services:

Criteria for Evaluation of Technical Proposals, Section 24.3 of the Instructions to Bidders, p. 23 of the Bidding Documents	<p>Technical proposals will be evaluated based on the following criteria:</p> <p><u>For individual consultants:</u></p> <ol style="list-style-type: none">1. Qualification of Consultant – 60 %2. Plan of Approach and Methodology – 30%3. Current Workload relative to Capacity – 10% <p><i>Consultant should get at least 50% of points for all criteria.</i></p> <p><u>For firms:</u></p> <ol style="list-style-type: none">1. Applicable Experience of the Firm – 5%2. Qualification of Assigned/Nominated Consultant – 60 %3. Plan of Approach and Methodology – 30%4. Current Workload relative to Capacity – 5% <p><i>Firm should get at least 50% of points for criteria 2 and 3. If the assigned/nominated expert/s are not organic/regular employees of the firm, a certification under oath should be submitted by each expert committing to render his/her services for the study if the firm is awarded the contract.</i></p> <p>In addition to meeting the 50% hurdle rate for the indicated criteria above, the technical proposal should get an overall score of at least 70% .</p>
