REQUEST FOR EXPRESSION OF INTEREST (EOI) AND SUBMISSION OF ELIGIBILITY DOCUMENTS FOR THE PROCUREMENT OF CONSULTING SERVICES FOR THE CONDUCT OF BASELINE STUDY FOR THE NEDA COMMUNICATION AND STAKEHOLDER ENGAGEMENT (CSE) FRAMEWORK

1. The National Economic and Development Authority (NEDA), through the Development Information Staff (DIS), intends to engage the services of a Consultant (foreign or local, individual or firm) for the conduct of the Baseline Study for the NEDA CSE Framework. The Approved Budget for the Contract (ABC) is **TWO MILLION AND 00/100 PESOS (PhP2,000,000.00)**, inclusive of all applicable government taxes and charges.
2. The NEDA now calls for the submission of EOI and eligibility requirements for the conduct of the abovementioned undertaking as provided for under Sections 24.1 and 24.2 of the Revised Implementing Rules and Regulations (IRR) of Republic Act (RA) No. 9184, or the Government Procurement Reform Act (GPRA), and in the Eligibility Documents / Eligibility Data Sheet (EDS)¹. Interested Consultants should submit their eligibility requirements on or before **11 August 2016 (Thursday), 12:00 P.M.** at the following address:

Only those Consultants who will submit EOI and pay the corresponding participation fee of **PhP2,000.00**, together with the required Eligibility Documents, and determined to be eligible and shortlisted shall be directly invited in the subsequent selection process and allowed to purchase the Bidding Documents.
4. Interested Consultants may submit their Legal, Financial and Class "B" Eligibility Documents, as applicable, in advance (**on or before 28 July 2016, 4:00 P.M.**) for preliminary evaluation by the NBAC-CS in terms of completeness/compliance. The NBAC-CS, however, shall only proceed with the preliminary evaluation when the required participation fee of PhP2,000.00 has been paid. Note that said amount shall cover the attendant administrative cost for the eligibility check and shortlisting process and shall be deducted from the cost of the Bidding Documents which the participating shortlisted Consultants are required to purchase. The NBAC-CS, after its preliminary evaluation of advance submissions, shall inform the Consultants of any deficiency in their respective submissions at least three (3) calendar days prior to the deadline for submission of Eligibility Documents set in this Request for EOI.

5. Eligibility and Selection will be conducted through open competitive selection process using non-discretionary "pass/fail" criterion as specified in RA 9184 and its Revised IRR. Proposals shall be evaluated using the Quality-Cost Based Evaluation/Selection (QCBE/QCBS) procedure. The criteria with rating system for the evaluation of proposals shall be provided in the Bidding Documents.
6. NEDA reserves the right to reject any and all proposals, including that of a single eligible proponent, waive any minor deviation in the submitted documents which will not materially affect the substance of the proposal, annul the bidding process, or not award the contract without thereby incurring any liability to the affected participating Consultants.
