REQUEST FOR EXPRESSION OF INTEREST (EOI) AND SIMULTANEOUS SUBMISSION OF ELIGIBILITY DOCUMENTS, TECHNICAL AND FINANCIAL PROPOSALS FOR THE NEGOTIATED PROCUREMENT OF THE EVALUATION CONSULTANT FOR THE MONITORING AND EVALUATION (M&E) FUND

1. The National Economic and Development Authority (NEDA), through the Monitoring and Evaluation Staff (MES), shall engage the services of an Evaluation Consultant (foreign or local) to provide advisory expert services for the efficient and effective conduct of (i) monitoring and evaluation, and other related studies, in priority areas; and, (ii) capacity building activities for NEDA and selected stakeholders. The Approved Budget for the Contract (ABC) is **TWO MILLION, EIGHT HUNDRED FIFTY THOUSAND and 00/100 PESOS (PhP2,850,000.00)**, inclusive of all applicable government taxes and charges.
2. The NEDA now calls for the simultaneous submission of Eligibility Documents, Technical and Financial Proposals, in three (3) separate sealed envelopes, for the conduct of the abovementioned undertaking in accordance with the Revised Implementing Rules and Regulations (IRR) of Republic Act (RA) No. 9184, or the Government Procurement Reform Act (GPRA), and the Eligibility Documents / Eligibility Data Sheet (EDS)¹. Interested Consultants should submit their eligibility requirements on or before **10 November 2016 (Thursday), 12:00 P.M.** at the following address:


3. Consultants are invited to attend the **Pre-Proposal Conference on 27 October 2016, 1:00 P.M.** at the Office of the Assistant Director-General for Investment Programming Conference Room, 4/F NEDA-sa-Pasig Building, #12 Saint Josemaria Escriva Drive, Ortigas Center, Pasig City provided that an EOI has been submitted.
4. Consultants with the required Eligibility Documents submitted, and determined to be legally, financially and technically eligible, shall be directly invited to the subsequent opening of the Technical and Financial Proposals. Proposals of Consultants who have not been determined to be eligible shall be returned unopened. Proposals shall be evaluated using the Quality-Based Evaluation/Selection (QBE/QBS) procedure. The criteria with rating system for the evaluation of proposals shall be provided in the Instructions to Bidders (ITB).

5. The Consultant whose Technical Proposal is responsive to the Terms of Reference (TOR) and rated highest shall be directly invited to the opening of its Financial Proposal. The Financial Proposal of the next highest rated Consultant shall only be opened if there is a failure of negotiation with the highest rated Consultant until a successful negotiation is completed. The Financial Proposal of a Consultant whose Technical Proposal is found to be deficient shall be returned unopened.
6. NEDA reserves the right to reject any and all proposals, including that of a single eligible proponent, waive any minor deviation in the submitted documents which will not materially affect the substance of the proposal, annul the bidding process, or not award the contract without thereby incurring any liability to the affected participating Consultant/s.
