Particulars	Clarification/Amendment
a. Scope of Works	<p>Relative to Section 3.1.1 of the Terms of Reference (TOR), the Consultant should assess and identify all direct and indirect economic benefits (including disbenefits, if any) within the Philippine context in undertaking social infrastructure projects under the following minimum study areas/subsectors:</p> <p>(a) Tourism; (b) Research and Development; (c) Urban Renewal; and, (d) Culture and Heritage.</p> <p>The Consultant, therefore, shall be given flexibility in exploring other study areas/subsectors to cover a broad range of social infrastructure projects under the Study.</p> <p>Similarly, the Consultant should cover as many types of projects as possible under each of the identified study areas/subsectors. For the Tourism Subsector, for example, the Study should cover projects such as, but not limited to, theme parks, recreational centers, and ecotourism projects.</p>
