#### **NEGOTIATED PROCUREMENT OF CONSULTING SERVICES FOR THE CONDUCT OF IMPACT EVALUATION OF THE TECHNICAL EDUCATION AND SKILLS DEVELOPMENT PROJECT**

Hereunder are clarifications on the above procurement:

<b>Subject</b>	<b>Clarification</b>
Coverage of the Study	The impact evaluation should only cover graduates of the TESDP implemented from 2001-2008. Based on the findings of the evaluation, the consulting firm shall formulate recommendations on the implementation of similar projects which are either currently ongoing (if any), or will be rolled out in the future.
Inclusion of current TESDP Program in the Study	The Terms of Reference (TOR) only covers the conduct of an impact evaluation of the completed TESDP (2001-2008).
Participation of NEDA Personnel in the Knowledge Transfer	The Consulting Firm is not expected to conduct classroom trainings for NEDA personnel. The NEDA personnel who will participate in the study are expected to be included in orientations/briefings on the preparation of the study methodology, in the conduct of field work, and in the analysis of data collected.
Number of NEDA Personnel	Two to five technical personnel from the NEDA Central Office, particularly from the Monitoring and Evaluation Staff (MES) shall participate in the study. The main task of said personnel is to monitor and evaluate the progress of implementation of development programs and projects, and recommend appropriate measures to hasten implementation.
Information Available for Consultants and other Sources	The project documents to be provided by NEDA are listed in the Annex. NEDA will assist the consultant in obtaining any further information/additional documents from other government agencies, as needed.
Presentation of Final Outputs and "Other Stakeholders"	The presentation of the draft and final outputs will be at the NEDA Central Office. NEDA may, however, opt to invite attendees from the regional offices and other government agencies to the presentation of the final output. Further, other stakeholders refer to implementing agencies (e.g., TESDA, DepEd, LBP, DOLE) and



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	government bodies (e.g., NEDA Committees, Regional Development Councils), among others. The consultant may also propose the inclusion of other relevant stakeholders based on their analysis of the project.
