NEDA BIDS AND AWARDS COMMITTEE FOR CONSULTING SERVICES (NBAC-CS) RESOLUTION No. 194 (2017)

RECOMMENDING AWARD OF CONTRACT FOR THE NEGOTIATED PROCUREMENT OF CONSULTING SERVICES FOR THE CONDUCT OF IMPACT EVALUATION OF THE RURAL ROAD NETWORK DEVELOPMENT PROJECT (RRNDP)

WHEREAS, the Terms of Reference (TOR) for the procurement of consultancy services for the impact evaluation of the Rural Road Network Development Project as submitted by the Monitoring and Evaluation Staff (MES) through negotiated procurement was approved through NBAC-CS Resolution No. 66 (2017) with an Approved Budget for the Contract (ABC) of Seventeen Million One Hundred Forty Two Thousand Seven Hundred Pesos (Php17,142,700.00), inclusive of all applicable government taxes and charges, professional fees, and other incidental and administrative costs;

WHEREAS, on the deadline for the simultaneous submission and subsequent opening of submissions on August 15, 2017, the following firms (3) submitted complete submissions (eligibility, technical and financial proposals):

1. Angelo King Institute for Economic and Business, (DLSU-AKI);
2. Associated Resources for Management and Development, Inc., (ARMDEV); and
3. JV of CPRM Consultants, Inc., (CPRM) and Transport and Traffic Planners, Inc., (TTPI);

WHEREAS, on August 22, 2017, the Technical Working Group (TWG) presented the results of the evaluation of the technical proposal to the NBAC-CS as shown below:

WHEREAS, on August 30, 2017, the NBAC met with the three firms and negotiated on their proposals, particularly on the two key points: (a) qualification of personnel; and (b) plan of approach and methodology;

WHEREAS, the NBAC-CS through letter dated September 4, 2017, formally affirmed that deadline for the submission of the firms' best and final offer composed of one original copy and four copies each of the technical and financial offers was on September 14, 2017, 12:00 PM;

WHEREAS, NBAC-CS Bid Bulletin No. 2 was issued on September 7, 2017 informing the rescheduling of the deadline of submission of the firms' best and final offer to September 15, 2017, 12:00 PM and of the opening to September 15, 2017 at 12:15 PM;

WHEREAS, all firms submitted their best and final offers before said deadline;

WHEREAS, following were the results of the evaluation by the TWG of the technical component of best and final offers:

DLSU-AKI	76.8	61.4	Passed
JV of CPRM and TTPI	79.9	64.0	Passed

WHEREAS, based on the 80% and 20% weights for the evaluation of technical and financial proposals, respectively, using the Quality-Cost Based Selection/Evaluation (QCBSE) procedure as approved by the Head of Procuring Entity (HOPE), JV of CPRM and TTPI was determined to be the highest rated bidder as approved through NBAC-CS Resolution No. 161 (2017):



DLSU-AKI	61.4	19.5	80.9	2

WHEREAS, post-qualification documents were submitted by JV of CPRM and TTPI which the TWG found in order;

NOW, THEREFORE, for and in consideration of the foregoing premises, the NBAC for Consulting Services hereby resolves, as it is hereby resolved, to recommend to the HOPE the award of contract to **JV of CPRM Consultants, Inc., (CPRM) and Transport and Traffic Planners, Inc., (TTPI)** as the highest rated responsive bidder for the procurement of **Consulting Services for the Impact Evaluation of the Rural Road Network Development Project** in the amount of **Sixteen Million Five Hundred Fifty Two Thousand Three Hundred Sixty Five Pesos (PhP16,552,365.00)** inclusive of all applicable government taxes and charges, professional fees, and other incidental and administrative costs.




