

Bidding Document, Item 5.2 TOR, page 105 Deputy Team Leader/Land Use Planner	<ul style="list-style-type: none">Item 5.2 of the TOR is intended for the Land Use Planner who may also secondarily be a DTL.The Deputy Team Leader (DTL) and the Land Use Planner is not a separate position that requires separate experts. The DTL role/function is allowed to be transferred to other experts in the project.
Bidding Document, Item 5 of the TOR, page 104 Qualifications of the Experts related to their Bachelor's and Master's Degree	<ul style="list-style-type: none">Bachelor's and Master's Degree could be interchangeableThe degree or the specialization can either be in the Bachelor's, Master's or PhD, as long as those fields are specifically the expertise of the nominated personnel.
Proposal for Additional Experts/Position	<ul style="list-style-type: none">TOR, page 112 of the Bidding Document states that <i>"The Consulting Firm may hire, as it deems necessary and at its own expense, additional experts to ensure the quality and timely delivery of the scope of work of the consultancy service"</i>.Bidders may propose additional position at no additional cost. Bidders should work within the proposed budget for the project.

1. The first part of the paper is devoted to a general discussion of the problem of the existence of solutions of the system of equations

which are satisfied by the functions $u_i(x, y, z)$ and $v_i(x, y, z)$ in the domain D of the space E_3 . It is shown that the system of equations is solvable in the domain D if and only if the functions $f_i(x, y, z)$ and $g_i(x, y, z)$ satisfy certain conditions.

2. In the second part of the paper the problem of the construction of the solutions of the system of equations is solved.
