

Section 2, last paragraph (<i>Objectives & Expected Outputs</i>), Terms of Reference (TOR) | <p>By the end of the contract period under this TOR, the Consulting Firm is expected to produce twelve (12) comprehensive Final Reports/Studies, and provide knowledge and technology transfer to at least (4) LWUA representatives as part of the VE/VA.</p> <p>Representatives for the knowledge and technology transfer as part of the VE/VA will be determined during the conduct of the Study.</p> |
| 2. Section 3, TOR (<i>Scope of Works – Table: 2nd row, 4th column</i>) | Bayombong, Nueva Vizcaya |
| 3. Section 3.1.2.b, TOR (<i>Scope of Works – Assessment of the River Potential</i>) | Determination of 5-, 10-, 25- and 50-years Low, Mean, Max Flows: involves the use of appropriate statistical techniques through open/public domain software; |
| 4. Section 3.1.2.c, TOR (<i>Scope of Works – Assessment of the River Potential</i>) | Determination of Water Quality: involves the collection of surface water sample analysis, especially for turbidity and sediment yield, and the classification of the river based on DAO 2016-08; |

Section 5.10.2, TOR (<i>VE/VA Specialist</i>) | <p>The Curriculum Vitae (CV) of the Value Engineering/Value Analysis (VE/VA) Specialist should be notarized or consularized.</p> <p>In view of several ongoing procurements requiring a VE/VA Specialist, NEDA will accept Certified True Copy (CTC) of the consularized CV during proposal/bid submission. Accordingly, the Highest Rated and Responsive Bidder shall present the original consularized CV upon the submission of post-qualification requirements.</p> |

Counterpart personnel | <p>The counterpart personnel (i.e., up to four (4) technical personnel from NEDA an NIA) shall be detailed to the project as observers and for the purpose of capacity building and technology transfer.</p> <p>The cost of logistics for the counterpart personnel was incorporated in the ABC and shall be shouldered by the Consulting Firm.</p> |
