PURCHASE OF TABLET COMPUTERS FOR THE NATIONAL ECONOMIC AND
DEVELOPMENT AUTHORITY (NEDA)

TO : ALL PROSPECTIVE BIDDERS

Following the Pre-Bid Conference held on **29 July 2019, 10:30 A.M.**, hereunder are the clarifications and modifications on the above-cited procurement:

PARTICULARS	CLARIFICATIONS/AMENDMENTS/ REVISIONS
1. Item V.3 of the Terms of Reference (TOR) (<i>Duties and Responsibilities of the Supplier</i>), page 85 of the Philippine Bidding Documents (PBD) and Item I.5 of Section VII (<i>Technical Specifications</i>), pages 64-65 of the PBD	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> In case of malfunction within the warranty period. The supplier shall conduct an on-site diagnostics of the unit for repair. Feedback should be given to the NEDA within five (5) working days. All repairs shall be made within 45 working days. In the event that the unit is beyond repair, the Supplier shall provide a new unit or a unit with higher specification at no additional cost to the government.
2. Annex 1 or TOR (<i>Detail Technical Specification</i>), pages 87-90 of PBD	Color preference is Silver . Other option is Gold .
3. Item VII.2 of TOR (<i>Additional Qualification Requirements</i>) page 86 of PBD Certificate of Authorized Reseller	Certification from the distributor/manufacture of the tablet computer brand being offered that the bidder is an authorized reseller or professional partner of the former; or The certificate of authorized reseller from the authorized distributor must be accompanied by a certificate of authorized distributorship from the product principal .
4. Technical Components of Bid - Item 12.1(a)(ii) of Section III (Bid Data Sheet), page 39 of PBD Clarification on Statement of Single	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> The bidder's SLCC similar¹ to the contract to be bid should have been completed within five (5) years prior to the deadline for the submission and receipt of bids.

¹ Similar contract pertains to tablet computer, desktop computer and laptop computer or any IT products analogous to the subject procurement.

<p>Largest Completed Contract (SLCC)</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Noting that the subject procurement falls under Non-Expendable Supplies², Section 23.4.1.3 of the 2016 Revised Implementing Rules and Regulations (IRR) of Republic Act (RA) No. 9184 or the “Government Procurement and Reform Act (GPRA)”, states, <p><i>“xxx an SLCC that is similar to the contract to be bid, and whose value, adjusted to current prices using the Philippine Statistics Authority (PSA) consumer price indices, must be at least fifty percent (50%) of the ABC xxx”</i></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <u>Reminder</u> - bidders shall submit Annexes A and A-1 as stated in Item 12.1(a)(ii) of Section III (BDS).

On Eligibility Requirements</p> <p>Submission of PhilGEPS Certificate of Registration (Platinum Membership)</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> The PhilGEPS Certificate of Registration (Platinum Membership) will be accepted provided that all Class “A” Eligibility Documents under Annex “A” i.e., Business Registration Certificate, Tax Clearance Certificate, Mayor’s/Business Permit, Latest Audited Financial Statement are current and valid. The Class “A” Eligibility Documents will be required for submission during the post-qualification stage. In case the bidder opted to submit Class “A” Documents, <i>the Certificate of PhilGEPS Registration (Platinum Membership)</i> shall remain a post-qualification requirement pursuant to Section 34.2 of the 2016 Revised IRR of RA 9184 and GPPB Circular No. 07-2017, Deferment of the Implementation of the Mandatory Submission of PhilGEPS Certificate of Registration and Membership).

Reminders</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Bid Security shall be in any of the following: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> a. <u>Bid Securing Declaration</u> – should be notarized with government-issued ID (<i>Note: Community Tax Certificate is no longer accepted as a competent evidence of identity</i>); or b. <u>Cash, cashier’s/manager’s check, bank draft/guarantee/irrevocable letter of credit</u> – 2% of ABC; or c. <u>Surety Bond</u> – 5% of ABC

² **Non-Expendable Supplies** - Refer to articles which are not consumed in use and ordinarily retain their original identity during the period of use, whose serviceable life is more than one (1) year and which add to the assets of the GoP.

| | <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Use up to date forms (follow the format of the forms included in the bidding documents) and ensure that these are properly notarized (e.g., Omnibus Sworn Statement, Bid Securing Declaration) <ul style="list-style-type: none"> a. Person who sworn in the Omnibus Sworn Statement should be consistent with the authorized person in the Secretary's Certificate. b. All Bid Documents should be signed/executed by the person authorized in the Secretary's Certificate. c. In case the person authorized in the Secretary's Certificate delegates his/her authority, the same should be specified in the Secretary's Certificate. d. Consistencies on date specified in Secretary's Certificate (e.g., date of board meeting against date of invitation to bid) • Deadline for additional queries and requests for clarification is on August 1, 2019. The NBAC-GIP shall respond through bid bulletin not later than August 06, 2019. • Only Bidders who have paid the non-refundable participation fee not later than the deadline for submission of bids shall be qualified to bid; and • Deadline for submission of bids – 13 August 2019, 10:00 A.M. Observe timeliness; 1 minute late is strictly considered LATE. |
